Types of papers

Research paper, viewpoint, technical paper, conceptual paper, case study, literature review and general review

Submissions

Peer review

PAP operates a double-blind peer review model. All submitted papers undergo an initial assessment by the journal editors. If they are considered suitable for peer review, they will then be reviewed by a minimum of two external reviewers to assess their suitability for publication. Final responsibility for editorial decisions rests with the Editor-in-Chief.

Open access

All articles in PAP are published in Open Access under a CC BY 4.0 licence.
